



The Stevensville Scarecrow Festival is a public art project produced by the Stevensville Art & Sculpture Society (SASS)



It is open to individuals, groups, teams, organizations, and/or businesses who create outdoor sculptures reflecting the themes of scarecrows, fall, crows, etc.

The sculptures are displayed along the pathway north of town for a period of one week starting on the first Friday in October. The main event is associated with the Stevensville Main Street Association First Friday activities. On First Friday the sculptures are judged. Prizes are awarded for the Peoples' Choice and for Artistic Merit.

<b>PRIZES</b>	<p>People's Choice Awards are determined through balloting on Friday 10/1 from 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM along the pathway outside of Stevensville; Artistic Merit awards are determined by a panel of three judges from SASS.</p> <p>Peoples' Choice Awards: 1st Place \$300, 2nd Place \$200, 3rd Place \$100 Artistic Merit Awards: Two awards of \$50 each</p> <p>Winners will be notified by telephone and/or email and published in both the Bitterroot Star and the Ravalli Republic in the Wednesday editions following the festival.</p>
<b>TERMS AND CONDITIONS</b>	Entrants agree that 1) SASS assumes no liability for theft and/or damage to scarecrows and 2) SASS or third parties (e.g., newspapers) have the right to use images of the scarecrows and/or other information provided by the entrants.
<b>CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION</b>	<p>Scarecrows may be any size and constructed with any material. Scarecrows are to be installed between 5 PM, Thursday, Sep 30<sup>th</sup> and 4 PM, Friday, Oct 1st. The scarecrows will be displayed along the path at the north end of town. Entrants must provide their own installation and hardware. A metal fence post 5' above ground will be provided. You will receive a number of the post for your installation. Due to the presence of underground wiring and/or water systems, no additional stakes are allowed. Stakes are the property of SASS and are not to be removed.</p> <p>Scarecrows must be removed by Saturday, Oct 9th</p>
